



Did you know that the PVAAS Portal now includes reports based on locally administered assessments?


LEA/Districts and schools can now view longitudinal individual student assessment history and growth reporting across a variety of assessments – PSSA, Keystones, PSAT, ACT, SAT, ACCESS for ELLs, and Advanced Placement alongside Classroom Diagnostic Tools, national norm referenced assessments, and other locally administered assessments that meet analyses/reporting criteria.

### **Expanded View of Students' Growth and Achievement**

- Local assessment results are reported alongside state assessment results: LEAs/Districts, school, grade, subject, student groups and student.
- Alignment of reporting and triangulation of data from state assessments and locally administered assessments to provide increased evidence to support educators' decisions.
- Local assessment and state assessment results follow students across schools, LEAs, and across school years.
- Create an expanded suite of reporting to include subjects and grade levels that do not receive PVAAS reporting from state assessments, including K-3 and additional high school grade levels.


#### How Do I Obtain Reporting?

- The following local assessments were included in the PVAAS reporting for LEAs/schools: Classroom Diagnostic Tools (CDTs), Acadience (DIBELS Next), Aimsweb, DIBELS, EasyCBM, Exact Path, FastBridge, i-Ready, MAP and STAR.
- LEAs/Districts voluntarily submit their locally administered assessment data into PIMS. This PIMS collection is now open! Data submission timelines for each year can be found on the PIMS Manuals and Calendar webpage.
  - If your local assessment is not currently listed above, you can still submit it. SAS® EVAAS will verify whether it meets all requirements. You can also email the PVAAS Statewide Team for PDE at <a href="mailto:pdepvaas@iu13.org">pdepvaas@iu13.org</a> to find out more about this process and requirements.
  - PDE will submit Classroom Diagnostic Tools (CDTs) on behalf of LEAs.
- This reporting is released on the PVAAS Portal to LEAs/districts and schools.




#### LEA/District and School Value-Added Report

K-12 reporting suite for value-added based on state and local assessments.




### LEA/District and School Growth of Student Groups Report
