Redesign of Student Reports

Student reports, which include student testing history, projections, and demographics displayed in customized data tiles, have been updated with additional content and a user-friendly interface. The Student report desk reference in the PVAAS Virtual Shelf provides detailed information about this redesigned report and how to navigate new click paths.

District and School Value-Added Updates

The 2022-23 reporting enables users to compare up to 10 LEAs/districts or schools on the District and School Value-Added report. Users also have the option to download their district and school value-added data directly from this report.

Teacher Value-Added Composite Updates

The 2022-23 reporting includes one-year and two-year composites for Teacher Value-Added reports.

Scatterplot Updates

For users with access to Teacher Summary reports, Scatterplots include 2022-23 Teacher growth data. This report enables you to create graphs that display the relationship between two metrics, such as growth and achievement, to view student learning patterns in LEAs/districts, schools, or classrooms.

District and School CDT Value-Added Reporting Updates

The 2022-23 LEA/district and school value-added reporting for all CDT assessments is calculated using the predictive methodology.

Removal of PVAAS Reports

With the 2022-23 reporting release, the following reports have been removed from the PVAAS website as their functionality is now part of the LEA/District and School Value-Added and Diagnostic reports:

- District and School Launchpad report
- District and School Value-Added Summary report
- District Quintile Diagnostic Summary and District Performance Diagnostic reports
 - School Quintile Diagnostic Summary and School Performance Diagnostic reports remain available under Comparison Reports.
